
# **ABSTRACT**

How is it similar? How is it different?






# **PATTERN**

What patterns do you see?






# **RHYTHM**

Using your body, show the movement (or rhythm) you notice in this painting.






### **MOSAIC**

Why do you think this painting can be described as as a mosaic?






### **VERTICAL**
